BRAMBER PRIMARY SCHOOL HOME LEARNING (HOMEWORK) POLICY

At Bramber Primary School, the purpose of learning at home is:

- To offer opportunities to practice skills and embed classroom learning;
- To further stimulate enthusiasm for learning;
- To provide learning that is achievable independently, with parents/carers facilitating the tasks;
- To experience success by completing activities that access prior learning from school;
- To offer opportunities for familiarisation for assessments: (i.e. phonics check, multiplication check, SATs)
- To help foster habits of organisation and self-discipline in preparation for the demands of secondary school.

Whilst we support all of the above key principles, Bramber Primary School is not a school at which homework dominates home and school life. We believe that homework should be enjoyable and manageable for all concerned and that if it becomes a chore, burden or source of conflict, it ceases to be a constructive aspect of teaching and learning.

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This year, our home learning is going to be very focused on spellings and times tables.

Year 3	What?	When?
Maths	TT Rockstars - online multiplication practice	At least three times a week for 10 minutes.
Reading	Comments recorded in the back of child's home learning book.	Daily for 15-20 minutes
Spelling Task	Task set every fortnight when spelling rule/pattern has been taught.	Spend at least 5 minutes daily on these words.
Topic words.	'Spelling Mat' with key words on, sent home at the start of every new topic.	Spend at least 10 minutes per week on these words
Writing - grid of activities	A grid of activities linked to learning sent at the start of each term.	To be completed over the term.
Optional Topic Task.	An art / craft activity linked to the learning sent at the start of each term.	To be completed over the term.
