Ducklings	- Join in discussions, role-play and activities based on key historical events and people - Know that people have not always lived in the same way through time. - Celebrate key historical events and people through storytelling and role-play. - Identify simple reasons for why life was different 'then' - Notice the difference between 'now and then' when looking at books, photos and artefacts. - Develop an awareness of historical sites having had a former 'life' - Talk about events from their own lives that have already happened - Order 2, then 3, events or artefacts. - Talk about the past using grammatical features of language and begin to use historical words and phrases - Recall familiar objects, people and events from history. Develop their historical vocabulary by exploring words. Talk about what they have learned. - Explore books, photographs and artefacts about the past. Ask questions that interest them.
